

Partial List of Rites Available for Use in Ministry to the Sick

Anointing Within Mass/Larger Number of Participants

Minister(s):	Priest, assisted by deacon and lay ministers
Recipient:	The sick as described in Church documents as candidates for Anointing (requires communication with parish office)
What is included:	Prayer for healing; Sacrament of Anointing; Eucharist
Possible texts:	<i>Pastoral Care of the Sick; Roman Missal</i> (Mass for the Sick; EP for Masses for Various Needs, #IV, "Jesus, Who Went About Doing Good")

Anointing Outside Mass

Minister(s):	Priest; may be assisted by other members of the faithful
Recipient:	The sick as described in Church documents as candidates for Anointing
What is included:	Prayer for healing; Sacrament of Anointing; may include Communion
Possible texts:	<i>Pastoral Care of the Sick</i>

Visits to Sick; Prayer/Communion Services for Healing

Minister:	Deacon or Lay Minister
Recipient:	The sick, individually or in groups, who may not require Anointing; the homebound; those mentioned in the <i>Book of Blessings</i> if they are not candidates for Anointing (the elderly, parents after a miscarriage, victims of crimes, etc.); those who may suffer addictions, etc., that may not require anointing
What is included:	Prayers for healing; may include Communion
Possible texts:	<i>Book of Blessings, Pastoral Care of the Sick</i>

Viaticum Within Mass

Minister:	Priest; may be assisted by deacon or lay ministers
Recipient:	The dying who are able to be present
What is included:	Clear celebration of the completion of baptism; Eucharist, with formula for Viaticum; prayers for mercy and a happy death; may include Apostolic Pardon
Possible texts:	<i>Pastoral Care of the Sick; Roman Missal</i>

Viaticum Outside Mass

Minister:	Priest, deacon, or lay minister
Recipient:	The dying
What is included:	Reception of Holy Communion; prayers for happy death and God's mercy; may include Penance and Apostolic Pardon if minister is a priest
Possible text:	<i>Pastoral Care of the Sick</i>
