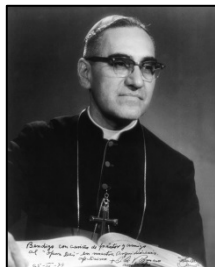

# IMPORTANT DATES IN THE LIFE OF POPE PAUL VI

9-26-1897	Giovanni Battista Montini born in Concesio, Italy; Second son of Giovanni Montini and Guiditta (Alghisi) Montini
9-30-1897	Baptized Giovanni Battista (John the Baptist) at local parish church in Concesio
June 6, 1907	Giovanni Battista Montini made his First Holy Communion
Feb 28 1920	Ordained a subdeacon
May 29, 1920	Ordained a priest in the cathedral at Brescia; First Mass at Church of St. Maria della Grazia
November 10	Bishop sends him to Rome for further studies arrives in Rome Nov 10
10-27-21	begins studies at the Academy for Noble Ecclesiastics, Holy See's school for diplomats
June 10,1923	Begins works at the nunciature in Warsaw, Poland
October 2, 1923	Summoned back to Rome to work at Secretary of State
1925	Chaplain to <i>Federazione Universitaria Catholica Italiana</i> (FUCI)
August 1954	Appointed Archbishop of Milan
November 1958	John XXIII names Archbishop Montini a cardinal (first among 23 names)
1-25-59	John XXIII announces his decision to hold an ecumenical council
1960	Cardinal Montini takes an extended vacation to the United States, received honorary doctorate from the University of Notre Dame
1961	Appointed to the Preparatory Committee for the Council
Oct 11, 1963	Opening of the Second Vatican Council
June 3, 1963	John XXIII dies on Pentecost Sunday
June 21, 1963	Cardinal Giovanni Montini elected as Pope; takes the name "Paul VI"
June 30	Coronation of Paul VI -- last to be crowned, he sold the tiara (a gift of the people of Milan) and gave the proceeds to charity. (It is found at the Basilica in Washington, DC.).
December 4, 1963	Promulgates the <i>Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy</i> and the <i>Decree on the Mass Media</i> Closes the second Session of the Council
Early 1964	Consilium ("council") established by Pope Paul VI for the implementation of the Constitution on the Liturgy — Cardinal Giacomo Lercaro, president Rev. Annibale Bugnini, C.M., secretary.
5-19-64	Establishes Pontifical Council for Interreligious Dialogue
9-26-64	<i>Inter Oecumenici</i> , Instruction on the orderly carrying out of the Constitution on the Liturgy, issued by the Concilium by mandate of Pope Paul VI
3-7-65	<i>Firsat Sunday of Lent, Pope celebrates Mass in the vernacular (Italian) at All Saints parish in Rome</i>
9-3-65	<i>Mysterium Fidei</i>
8-15-67	<i>Eucharisticum Mysterium Instruction on Worship of the Eucharist</i>
7-25-68	<i>Humanae Vitae</i>
1-25-69	<i>"Comme le Prévoit: On the Translation of Liturgical Texts for Celebrations with a Congregation"</i> promulgated by the Consilium and the Congregation for Divine Worship
4-3-69	<i>Apostolic Constitution, Missale Romanum</i> , promulgating the reform Order of Mass and its general norms. Implementation, First Sunday of Advent 11-30-69.
3-26-69	(Holy Thursday) first typical edition (i.e., the text to be used for translation) of the <i>Missale Romanum</i> /Roman Missal (RM) and <i>Institutio Generalis Missalis Romani</i> (IGMR)/ General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), published
11-27-70	Attempted assassination in the Philippines by a Bolivian artist
12-8-75	<i>Evangelii Nuntiandi on evangelization, to all the clergy and faithful of the world</i>
1975	Second typical edition of the RM and GIRM promulgated
8-6-78	Pope Paul VI dies at Castle Gandolfo
10-19-2014	Beatified by Pope Francis
10-14-18	Canonization Mass in Rome; St. Paul VI's feast will be the date of his birth - September 26
