

Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharistic Mystery Outside Mass – Simple Form

Rite with a Brief Celebration of the Word of God

42. This form is used when circumstances suggest that the form combined with a fuller celebration of the Word of God is not appropriate, especially when there are only one or two communicants and therefore, a celebration of the community cannot be arranged.

Norms Governing the Distribution of Holy Communion

19-20. When the location is a church or oratory, a corporal is placed on the altar that is already covered with an altar cloth. There should be two lit candles. If the minister is a Priest or Deacon, he should vest in an alb or surplice over a cassock. He should wear a stole. Other ministers should wear liturgical vesture approved by the Ordinary.
